



FACT SHEET: Juveniles (Under 18 years old) under Tennessee Department of Correction Jurisdiction on April 8, 2020

The data used for this fact sheet has been extracted from the Tennessee Offender Management Information System (TOMIS) and summarized by Decision Support: Research & Planning of the Tennessee Department of Correction.



- Ten (10) juveniles were under TDOC jurisdiction on April 8, 2020.
- Nine (9) juveniles were at the Northwest Correctional Complex in Tiptonville, TN and one (1) juvenile was at Montgomery County Jail.
- All ten (10) juveniles were 17 years old.
- Primary Offense categories were Aggravated Robbery (3), Homicide (2), Attempted Homicide (1), Aggravated Assault (1), Aggravated Sexual Battery (1), Aggravated Rape (1) and Robbery (1).
- Sentence range was 5 to 997 years for all ten (10) juveniles.
- Eight (8) juveniles were Black/African American and two (2) juveniles were White.
- All ten (10) juveniles were Male.




