Expiration Extension Notice

Dear Tennessee Commercial Driver License and Commercial Permit Holders,

Pursuant to Governor Bill Lee's Executive Order 55, signed July 31, 2020, the Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security has granted an extension to individuals with a Commercial Driver License, and Commercial Learner Permit, set to expire between March 12, 2020 and September 29, 2020. The new expiration date will be September 30th, 2020. Individuals eligible for the extension are listed below:

Class A, B, and C - Commercial Driver License holders;

Class PA, PB, and PC – Commercial Permit holders;

Please print a copy of this letter and maintain it with your expired Commercial Driver's License or Commercial Driver's Permit.

YOU MUST KEEP THIS LETTER WITH YOU WHEN DRIVING TO PROVE THE VALIDITY OF YOUR LICENSE or PERMIT. THIS NOTIFICATION LETTER TAKES PRECEDENCE OVER ANY PREVIOUSLY ISSUED LETTER TO THE CONTRARY.
