

**Jammie Castleman  
Revocation**

**The Background:**

*Facts:* In November 2016, Educator used inappropriate language such as the f\*\*\* word in his class. In December 2016, Educator was suspended for three days after encouraging/directing a student to repeat vulgar and sexually explicit language in front of his entire class. In March 2017, Educator was suspended pending an investigation into complaints from students and parents regarding an inappropriate vocabulary lesson about sexual innuendos and referring to students performing sexual acts. On March 16, 2017, Respondent resigned from Tipton County Schools in lieu of termination for inappropriate communication with students as the Director of Schools was prepared to recommend Educator for dismissal to the Tipton County Board of Education.

*Status:* Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to revoke his license based upon these findings and of his right to a hearing. Respondent received notice but did not request a hearing.

**The Recommendation:**

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for license revocation pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(2)(f).

The Board staff recommends revocation of Respondent's Tennessee educator license.
