ORDER OF DENIAL

The Tennessee State Board of Education (Board) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Jordan Manning (“Respondent”) applied for a license to teach in the State of Tennessee in 2014.

2. Respondent’s application indicated that he had a prior conviction for illegal possession of narcotics or drugs.

3. Respondent has not supplied requested information regarding the completion of his sentence in the indicated prior conviction.

4. Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board’s intent to deny his Tennessee license, and of his right to a hearing. The certified letter was returned unclaimed. The U.S. Postal Service notation that a properly addressed certified letter is “unclaimed” is sufficient evidence of the addressee's refusal to accept service and is sufficient legal notice to the addressee. By refusing delivery of the certified mail, Respondent has waived the right to a hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for denial, revocation, or suspension pursuant to Board Rule 0520-2-4-.01(9)(b)(6).

ORDER

The Tennessee State Board of Education hereby denies the issuance of a teaching license to Respondent.
