ORDER OF SUSPENSION

The Tennessee State Board of Education (Board) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. At all times pertinent hereto, Sharon Williams (Respondent) was licensed by the Board as a teacher in the State of Tennessee.

2. On May 13, 2014, the Mississippi Commission on Teacher and Administrator Education, Certification and Licensure and Development suspended Respondent's teaching license in the State of Mississippi.

3. The suspension was based on facts which would justify the Board's suspension of Respondent's Tennessee teaching license.

4. Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to revoke her license based upon these findings, and of her right to a hearing. Respondent received notice but did not request a hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for revocation, suspension, or reprimand pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-04-.01(9)(b)(5).

ORDER

The Tennessee State Board of Education hereby revokes Respondent's license. During the period of revocation, Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or be employed, directly or indirectly, as an educator, paraprofessional, aide, substitute teacher, or in any other position in a public school in the State of Tennessee.

Restoration shall be at the discretion of the Board, pursuant to Policy 5.500.
