ORDER OF REVOCATION

The Tennessee State Board of Education (Board) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On April 16, 2015, Leslie Acree (Respondent) resigned during Jackson-Madison County School System's investigation of inappropriate conduct.

2. Specifically, the conduct included an inappropriate relationship with a student and purchasing alcohol for a minor.

3. Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to revoke her license based upon these findings, and of her right to a hearing. Respondent received notice but did not request a hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for revocation, suspension, or reprimand pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(2)(f).

ORDER

The Tennessee State Board of Education hereby revokes Respondent's license as of the date of this order. During the period of revocation, Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or

be employed, directly or indirectly, as an educator, paraprofessional, aide, substitute teacher, or in any other position in a public school in the State of Tennessee.
