

ORDER OF REVOCATION

The Tennessee State Board of Education (Board) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. James Sales (Respondent) was a teacher licensed by the State of Tennessee.
2. On June 5, 2014, Respondent pled guilty to felony counts of aiding and abetting the misuse of Social Security Numbers in the United States District Court of the Western District of Tennessee.
3. Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to revoke his license based upon these findings, and of his right to a hearing. Respondent received notice but did not request a hearing.



CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for revocation, suspension, or reprimand pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(2)(a).

ORDER

The Tennessee State Board of Education hereby revokes Respondent's license as of the date of this order. During the period of revocation, Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or
