**ORDER OF REVOCATION**

The Tennessee State Board of Education (Board) disposes of this matter as follows:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Heather Wardlaw (Respondent) was a teacher licensed by the State of Tennessee.
2. In October, 2015, Respondent pled guilty to felony theft of property in Humphreys County Circuit Court.
3. Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to revoke her license based upon these findings, and of her right to a hearing. Respondent received notice but did not request a hearing.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for revocation, suspension, or reprimand pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(2)(a).

**ORDER**

The Tennessee State Board of Education hereby revokes Respondent's license as of the date of this order. During the period of revocation, Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or be employed, directly or indirectly, as an educator, paraprofessional, aide, substitute teacher, or in any other position in a public school in the State of Tennessee.


