ORDER OF REVOCATION

The Tennessee State Board of Education (“Board”) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. At all times pertinent hereto, Douglas Jett (“Respondent”) was a licensed teacher in the State of Tennessee.
2. On August 10, 2016, Respondent was convicted of three counts of aggravated sexual battery (felony) and sentenced to twelve years in prison.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Pursuant to T.C.A. §§49-5-417 and 40-35-501(i)(2)(H) and Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(1), (2)(a), and (2)(f), Respondent’s license is subject to revocation.

ORDER


The Board hereby revokes Respondent’s educator license effective on the date of this order. During the period of revocation, Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or be employed, directly or indirectly, as an educator, paraprofessional, aide, substitute teacher, or in any other position during the period of revocation. Restoration of Respondent’s license shall be at the discretion of the Board, pursuant to Board policy 5.500 – License Restoration Policy.
