ORDER OF RESTORATION

The Tennessee State Board of Education (“Board”) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. In 2014, Jermaine Johnson’s (“Respondent”) Tennessee educator license was revoked due to his involvement in paying someone to take the PRAXIS exam for Tennessee educator licensure on his behalf.
2. On March 12, 2019, Respondent submitted his application to restore his Tennessee educator license. Since the revocation of his educator license, Respondent has obtained his Master’s Degree, completed over 50 hours of community service, and passed the PRAXIS exam. Respondent submitted his own personal statement and various letters of recommendation from colleagues to the Board as part of his application for restoration.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(6)(b) and Board Policy 5.500 License Restoration Policy, Respondent’s license is subject to restoration.

ORDER

The Board hereby restores Respondent’s educator license. Provided other requirements for licensure are satisfied, the Office of Educator Licensing and Preparation (“OELP”) may issue and/or renew Respondent’s license.
