ORDER OF REVOCATION

The Tennessee State Board of Education (“Board”) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. At all times pertinent hereto, Jason Moore (“Respondent”), was a licensed teacher in the State of Tennessee.
2. On February 4, 2019, an Order of Judgment was entered in the Criminal/Circuit Court for Warren County, Tennessee against Respondent. Respondent pled guilty to one count of delivery or a schedule II controlled substance, a class C felony. Respondent was sentenced to 3 years in TDOC custody, which was suspended upon the condition that he successfully complete three years of supervised probation.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Because Respondent’s conviction is listed at Tenn. Code Ann. § 39-17-417, his teaching license is subject to automatic revocation pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(4)(a). Furthermore, as Respondent was convicted of a felony, his teaching license is subject to permanent revocation pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(5)(a)(1)(i).

ORDER

The Board hereby revokes Respondent’s educator license effective on the date of this order. Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or be employed, directly or indirectly, as an educator, paraprofessional, aide, substitute teacher, or in any other position.
