ORDER OF REVOCATION

The Tennessee State Board of Education (Board) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. At all times pertinent hereto, Aimee Cooley ("Respondent") was licensed by the State Board of Education ("Board") as a teacher in the State of Tennessee.

2. On July 18, 2008, Respondent voluntarily surrendered her Georgia teaching license after using a coworker's stolen credit card.

3. Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to revoke her license based upon these findings, and of her right to a hearing. Respondent received notice but did not request a hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for revocation or suspension pursuant to Board Rule 0520-2-4-.01(9)(b)(5).

ORDER

The Tennessee State Board of Education hereby revokes Respondent's license concurrent with the Georgia revocation. During the period of revocation, Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or be employed, directly or indirectly, as an educator, paraprofessional, aide, substitute teacher, or in any other position in a public school in the State of Tennessee.
