ORDER OF REVOCATION

The Tennessee State Board of Education (Board) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. At all times pertinent hereto, Terry Long (“Respondent”) was licensed by the State Board of Education (“Board”) as a teacher in the State of Tennessee.

2. In June 2013, The Kentucky Child Protective Services substantiated allegations of child abuse against Mr. Long.

3. On January 27, 2014, Respondent voluntarily surrendered his Kentucky teaching license.

4. Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board’s intent to revoke his license based upon these findings, and of his right to a hearing. Respondent received notice but did not request a hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent’s conduct constitutes grounds for revocation or suspension pursuant to Board Rule 0520-2-4-.01(9)(b)(5).

ORDER

The Tennessee State Board of Education hereby revokes Respondent's license concurrent with the Kentucky revocation. During the period of revocation, Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or be employed, directly or indirectly, as an educator, paraprofessional, aide, substitute teacher, or in any other position in a public school in the State of Tennessee.
