ORDER OF SUSPENSION

The Tennessee State Board of Education (Board) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. At all times pertinent hereto, Brandon Todd Belue ("Respondent") was licensed by the State Board of Education ("Board") as a teacher in the State of Tennessee.,
2. On August 21, 2012, Respondent resigned from Knox County Schools after engaging in inappropriate communications with students.
3. Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to suspend his license based upon these findings, and of his right to a hearing. Respondent received notice but did not request a hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for license revocation pursuant to Board Rule 0520-2-4-.01(9)(b)(6).

ORDER


The Tennessee State Board of Education hereby suspends Respondent's license for one (1) year from the effective date of this order. Reinstatement shall be contingent upon successful completion of educator boundary training.

During the period of suspension, Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or be employed, directly or indirectly, as an educator, paraprofessional, aide, substitute teacher, or in any other position in a public school in the State of Tennessee.
