ORDER OF DENIAL

The Tennessee State Board of Education (Board) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On July 15 2012, Respondent's Georgia teaching license was suspended for changing answers and/or cheating during the 2009 Criterion Referenced Competency Test.
2. Respondent has applied for a teaching license in Tennessee.
3. Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to deny her license application based upon these findings. Respondent received notice but did not request a hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for denial, revocation, or suspension pursuant to Board Rule 0520-2-4-.01(9)(b)(5).

ORDER

The Tennessee State Board of Education hereby denies Respondent's license application. During the period of denial, Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or be employed, directly or indirectly, as an educator, paraprofessional, aide, substitute teacher, or in any other position in a public school in the State of Tennessee.
