ORDER OF SUSPENSION

The Tennessee State Board of Education (Board) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. At all times pertinent hereto, Greg Hudson ("Respondent") was licensed by the State Board of Education ("Board") as an administrator in the State of Tennessee.
2. In April 2014, Respondent was suspended without pay for six days from Tipton County Schools for improperly depositing and using school funds.
3. Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to suspend his license based upon these findings, and of his right to a hearing. Respondent received notice but did not request a hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for license revocation or suspension pursuant to Board Rule 0520-2-4-.01(9)(b)(6).

ORDER


The Tennessee State Board of Education hereby suspends Respondent's administrator license for one (1) year from the effective date of this order.

During the period of suspension, Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or be employed, directly or indirectly, as an administrator in a public school in the State of Tennessee.
