ORDER OF DENIAL

The Tennessee State Board of Education (Board) disposes of this matter as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Laketa Bowles' ("Respondent") Georgia teaching license was suspended for breach of testing security during the 2013 Criterion Referenced Competency Test (CRCT).
2. Respondent has applied for a teaching license in Tennessee.
3. Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to deny her application, based upon these findings, and of her right to a hearing. Respondent received notice but did not request a hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for denial, revocation, or suspension pursuant to Board Rule 0520-2-4-.01(9)(b)(5).

ORDER

The Tennessee State Board of Education hereby denies Respondent's license application concurrent with the Georgia suspension. During the period of denial, Respondent shall not serve as a volunteer or be employed, directly or indirectly, as an educator, paraprofessional, aide, substitute teacher, or in any other position in a public school in the State of Tennessee.
